

## Setup Email Accounts to be used with Document Output




From version 17.3 of Business central and Version 3.2.6.0 of Document Output we now use the standard BC Email Accounts instead of the SMTP setup. (In BC there is a limitation of 4 MB when using the Email Accounts)

1. Search for "Email Accounts" in the search field
2. Setup the Accounts you need to use

3. If you use the From Emails from the templates, you need to setup e.g. the current user if you use mail from user setup.
4. You can setup multiple account type, if Document Output can't find the email that is set on the template in From Email. It will fall back to the default Email that is chosen.
